

2025 JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE TEAM INFO

COMMITMENTS / OBLIGATIONS

- a) The 2025 Junior BOP Representative Player Fees will be: \$385.00. An invoice for this will be emailed within 1 week of the teams' announcements.
 - These player fees entitle the players to attend the Performance Centre trainings / practices held in Rotorua on Tuesday Evenings, Awakeri on Wednesday Evenings and Tauranga on Thursday evenings.
 - There will be Sunday Afternoon team trainings held in Tauranga Venues to be confirmed.
 - Payment of this fee must be paid by the due date (or a payment plan put in place and the first payment received).
 - All outstanding invoices (for those who have not organised a payment plan) will incur a 10% penalty.
 - That the BOPBA player fees are paid in full before the Palmerston North Trip commences. The BOPBA has 'No Pay, No Play' stance regarding this matter and will only make exception by personal arrangement. - b) **ALL** junior players are also required to be a member of a BOP Affiliated Club. The list of clubs are as follows:

- d) There will be a compulsory parents meeting prior to the Palmerston North Trip. Date & Time will be advised.

e) That you wear the provided BOPBA player shirts (with either navy or black shorts/skirts) for all Representative Team Events. Badminton NZ requires each association to register its representative team uniforms and may fine associations/individual players for not wearing team uniform.

COMPULSORY EVENTS

Junior Age Group National Championship Teams Event:

The u13's, u15's, u17's and u19's teams will compete at the New Zealand Junior Teams Championships held at Palmerston North. This event is to be held from Sunday 7th July – Wednesday 10th July 2024. (Travel days are Saturday 6th and Thursday, 11th July).

The cost for a player to go to Palmerston North – NZ Team Championships (u13's, u15's, u17's & 19's teams) is approximately \$550 - \$650 for Travel, Accommodation and Food and the tournament souvenir shirt).

Applications will be made to Charitable Trusts for grants that may allow this amount to be reduced, however players and parents must be able to pay the full cost if these applications are not successful.

Players and Parents will also be required to help with fundraising initiatives to help with costs. Those players/parents who do not help with fundraising, will not benefit from the fundraising.

Players **MUST** stay with the team and each team will have a Coach, Manager and 1-2 Parent Helper stay with them.

Supporters are welcome but must organize own transport and accommodation separate from the team.

Players who withdraw from a team prior to the trip to Palmerston North due to illness or injury, will still be responsible for costs incurred by BOPBA in planning for this trip.

BOP /North Island Under 15 & Under 19 Champs

Players eligible will be expected to play in this event that will be held in Tauranga at the QEYC on Thursday, 24th April, Friday, 25th April & Saturday 26th April 2025.

All junior players are encouraged to play in the BOP ABCD Championships to be held at Rotorua Badminton Hall on Friday evening, 18th July, Saturday, 19th July and Sunday, 20th July 2025.

Junior players are also encouraged to play in the BOP Interclub Competition for their Club to be held in Tauranga on Saturday, 16th August and & Saturday 13th September 2025.

All Junior Players and Parent/Caregiver MUST sign the Junior Player & Caregiver Agreement and return a copy to BOP Badminton along with a completed Junior Medical Form upon notification of being selected.

Players and Caregivers should also make themselves familiar with the Representative Selections and Appeals Policy.
