



## 2026 SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS TERMS & CONDITIONS

### **The 2026 BOP Representative Player Fees will be:**

Seniors: (Squad Training & Rep Team)	\$600.00
Seniors: (Rep Team Only – no squad practises)	\$200.00

There is a 20% discount for players playing in multiple age group teams.

### **Player Fee Invoices:**

An invoice will be prepared and sent to you by Bay of Plenty Badminton Association within one (1) week of the teams being announced.

Payment of this fee must be paid prior to your first inter-association tie (or a payment plan put in place).

All outstanding invoices will incur a 10% penalty.

This fee is non-refundable. If you injure yourself during the season – this then allows BOP Badminton to find replacements at short notice for your place in the team.

The BOP Association has a 'No Pay, No Play' stance regarding this matter and will only make exception by personal arrangement. Please contact Delwyn Cooper to set up payment arrangements.

### **TIES**
